**NOTICE: PUBLICATION OF THE APPROVED
STRATEGIC TRANSPORT PLAN (STP) FOR GAUTENG
PROVINCE**



The Member of the Executive Council (MEC) tasked with Roads and Transport in the Gauteng Province hereby gives notice in terms of section 7(14) of the Gauteng Transport Authority Act, 2019 (Act No 2 of 2019) that the Strategic Transport Plan (STP) for Gauteng has been approved and is hereby officially published.

Purpose of the Strategic Transport Plan

In accordance with Section 7(3) - (4) of the Act, the approved Strategic Transport Plan:

- Provides a long-term strategic planning framework for the development of transport infrastructure and services within Gauteng;
- Guides and coordinates the future development of the provincial transport system over a period of not less than 5 years and not more than 15 years;
- Supports integrated planning across municipalities, public transport authorities, transport operators, users and other spheres of government.
- Sets the strategic direction for investment, operational planning, modal integration, infrastructure expansion, transport governance and long-term mobility outcomes in Gauteng.

Strategic Focus Areas of the Approved STP

The approved Plan provides for, amongst others:

- a) Integrated and inter-modal transport development;
- b) Public transport network enhancement and system integration;
- c) Travel demand management, universal access and safety improvements;
- d) Infrastructure expansion and maintenance prioritisation;
- e) Strategic freight mobility and logistics corridors;
- f) Institutional coordination and regulatory harmonisation across spheres of government;
- g) Long-term transport system sustainability, innovation and transformation.

Legal Effect of this Notice

This publication fulfils the requirement of section 7(14) of the Gauteng Transport Authority Act, 2019, which obliges the responsible MEC to publish the approved Strategic Transport Plan in the Provincial Gazette and take such steps as are reasonable and practical to implement the Plan.

The Strategic Transport Plan is therefore officially in force with effect from the date of publication of this notice.

Effective Date

The Strategic Transport Plan for Gauteng becomes operational on the date of publication of this notice in the Gauteng Provincial Gazette.
